Applications are currently being accepted for the above full-time position within the Public Works Wastewater Division. This position performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled tasks associated with the operation and maintenance of the treatment plant and facilities including the poplar tree effluent reuse system, biosolids application system and NPDES compliance.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES: (examples of duties)

- Daily Equipment preventive maintenance rounds to ensure proper operation of facility equipment.
- Performs specific tasks associated with the development and maintenance of Poplar Plantation, Irrigation Systems, and transplanting and duplicating of plants, shrubs, trees, and flowers, and operations of force mains and lift stations.
- Repairs city irrigation equipment and facilities as needed using plumbing, mechanical, and carpentry skills; operates sprinkler system to water grounds, lawn and tree plantation.
- Paints city buildings; performs minor carpentry, concrete work, asphalt work, and roof repair; performs minor repairs on equipment.
- Maintains turf areas by mowing, trimming, edging, spraying, and related tasks; determines appropriate chemicals for pest control and lawn conditioning.
- Spreads wastewater bio-solids and maintains bio-solids drying beds; performs preventative maintenance of equipment used for bio-solid disposal; operates and maintains Facultative Sludge Lagoon Dredges and bio-solids pump station.
- Assist wastewater staff with back-flow prevention and grease trap programs to insure compliance with NPDES permit;
- Reports supply and equipment repair needs to supervisor; assists with inventory control and recordkeeping.
- Performs related tasks as assigned.

NECESSARY SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a valid Oregon Pesticide Operator's license and valid Oregon driver's license. Within 6 months of employment, must possess a Dept. of Agriculture Right-of-Way Regulatory Weed Control License, Dept. of Agriculture Vertebrate Pest Control License, and Dept. of Agriculture Herbicide License.
